HOW TO GET TO OSTRAVA

By plane directly to Ostrava: Leos Janacek International Airport Ostrava (OSR) from Düsseldorf (DUS), London (STN), Paris (Charles De Gaulle) and Prague (PRG). Leos Janacek Ostrava International Airport (OSR) is located just 20 km from the city centre and can be easily reached by taxi – the fare is around 750 CZK (approx. 28 EUR).

By plane to Prague (Czech Republic): Vaclav Havel Airport Prague (PRG)

By plane to Vienna (Austria): <u>Flughafen Wien</u>
By plane to Katowice (Poland): <u>Katowice Airport</u>

By train or by bus from Prague / from Vienna / from Katowice to Ostrava:

From the train station Ostrava–Svinov you can take the bus number 37 to the bus stop Studentske koleje (last stop), which is in front of the university hotel. You can also take tram no: 7, 17, 8, which stop on Rektorat VSB tram stop in front of the venue.

By car: the City of Ostrava is an important transport hub and the main intersection of the Moravian-Silesian Region. It is easily accessible from several directions. The city area is crossed by an important international route – the I/11 – E75 (from Budapest to Gdansk). Ostrava is connected to the rest of Europe with the completion of the D47 highway, which will join up with the D1 (Prague/Brno) and the Polish A1 (Katowice/Gdansk/Helsinki). The D47 is a part of the VI.B Trans European network (TEN) multimodal corridor going North – South, from Katowice – Bohumín – Ostrava – Brno – Vienna.
