#### HOW TO GET TO OSTRAVA

**By plane directly to Ostrava:** Leos Janacek International Airport Ostrava (OSR) from **Düsseldorf (DUS)**, **London (STN)**, **Paris (Charles De Gaulle)** and **Prague (PRG)**. Leos Janacek Ostrava International Airport (OSR) is located just 20 km from the city centre and can be easily reached by taxi – the fare is around 750 CZK (approx. 28 EUR).

**By plane to Prague (Czech Republic):** Vaclav Havel Airport Prague (PRG)

**By plane to Vienna (Austria):** Flughafen Wien

**By plane to Katowice (Poland):** Katowice Airport

**By train or by bus from Prague / from Vienna / from Katowice to Ostrava:**

**From the train station Ostrava–Svinov** you can take the bus number 37 to the bus stop Studentske koleje (last stop), which is in front of the university hotel. You can also take tram no: 7, 17, 8, which stop on Rektorat VSB tram stop in front of the venue.

**By car:** the City of Ostrava is an important transport hub and the main intersection of the Moravian-Silesian Region. It is easily accessible from several directions. The city area is crossed by an important international route – the I/11 – E75 (from Budapest to Gdansk). Ostrava is connected to the rest of Europe with the completion of the D47 highway, which will join up with the D1 (Prague/Brno) and the Polish A1 (Katowice/Gdansk/Helsinki). The D47 is a part of the VI.B Trans European network (TEN) multimodal corridor going North – South, from Katowice – Bohumín – Ostrava – Brno – Vienna.
